
- Site Plan must be submitted with pool permit application and, once approved, adhered to.
- Property owner is solely responsible for being aware of and complying with any private covenants, conditions, or restrictions that apply to the property.
- Additional permit applications for plumbing and/or electrical may be required.

EXAMPLE SITE PLAN

ILLUSTRATION - FOR INFORMATIONAL USE ONLY

- Property lines must be indicated with heavy black line.
- Primary and any other existing structures must be drawn on plan with dimensions.
- Dimensions required at M'.
 Includes existing and proposed buildings, setbacks from property lines, parking, etc.
- Dimensions to include area, lenth, width, and height.

Site Plan may be hand drawn using a ruler, but must be drawn to scale.
