Statement of Purpose:

It is the intent and purpose of this bid for the partial paving of three (3) locations within the City of Riverside municipal limits.

The City of Riverside will consider bid packages received no later than **Monday, March 6, 2023, at 2:00pm** CST from qualified contractors. All bidders must use the attached Bid Proposal Form. Bids shall be clearly marked "Sealed Bid R0110-23" and the Contractor's Name. Any firm or bid package which is found not in compliance with the Request for Bid specifications and requirements may be disqualified from the bid.

Scope of Service:

Repair and Surfacing of the below.

- Sparrow Lane
- Lakeview Circle
- Broken Arrow Creek Road

Bid will include all labor, materials, equipment, shipping and postage, overhead, profit, bonds, insurance and all other costs necessary to provide the complete services as outlined.

Bid Qualifications:

Licensed as required by Title 34, Chapter 8, Code of Alabama, 1975, and authorized to conduct business in the City of Riverside. Must provide copy of Alabama General Contractors License, the ability to provide a Certificate of Insurance for Comprehensive General Liability, Comprehensive Auto and Workman's Compensation, and the ability to maintain in full force and effect during the contract period entirety. Liability limits should be no less than \$500,000.00.

The bidder to whom award is made shall provide a Performance Bond equal to 100% of the contract Amount and the accepted bidder shall also provide insurance as required by the City.

Laws and Regulations: The Bidder agrees that all applicable State laws, municipal ordinances and the rules and regulations of all authorities having jurisdiction over the project shall apply to the contract throughout, and they will be deemed to be included in the contract the same as though herein written out in full.

1. **SAFETY AND HEALTH REGULATIONS FOR CONSTRUCTION:** The Contractor shall comply with the Department of Labor Safety and Health Regulations for construction promulgated under the Occupational Safety and Health Act of 1970 (PL-596) and under Section 107 of the Contract Work Hours and Safety Standards Act (PL-91-54). The contractor alone shall be responsible for the safety, efficiency, and adequacy of his plant, appliances, and methods, and for any damage which may result from their failure or their improper construction, maintenance, or operations.
All bids must comply with Alabama State Law, including but not limited to, Ala, Code (1975) 41-16-50 et seq. and provide all documentation of enrollment in the E-Verify Program pursuant to Ala. Code 31-13-9. All bid information must be typed or printed in black ink. Bids shall be clearly marked "sealed bid". Along with the bid name, number and date of opening listed on the outside of the bid package.
2. **PROJECT SITE:** The Contractor shall keep the project site clean at all times. No loose dirt or stockpiles shall be left in areas other than those areas approved by the City Representative. The City Representative may require the Contractor to clean up any portion of the Project as he deems necessary.
During construction, Contractor shall provide traffic control and signage at each of the locations.
3. **MATERIALS:** The Contractor agrees to comply with, and to require the compliance of all subcontractors with the provisions of Alabama law.
4. **EDGE OF PAVEMENT/SHOULDER PREPARATION:** This work shall include furnishing all labor, equipment, materials, and all incidentals necessary to prepare the existing edge of pavement and shoulder to accept the wearing asphalt overlay. This work shall include adequate clipping and blading of the shoulder, patching of edge deformities and breakouts, and other work necessary to ensure adequate structure is provided to support the new wearing asphalt surface. All prep work shall be a subsidiary obligation of the wearing asphalt unit price.
5. **PROVISIONS REQUIRED BY LAW DEEMED INSERTED:** Each and every provision of law and clause required by law to be inserted in this contract shall be deemed to be inserted herein and the contract shall be read and enforced as though it were included herein, and if through mistake or otherwise any such provision is not inserted, or is not correctly inserted, then upon the application of either party the contract shall forthwith be physically amended to make such insertion or correction.

Method of Award: Lowest Qualified Bidder - The contract will be awarded to the lowest responsible Bidder if the lowest bid, which has been submitted by a qualified bidder, does not exceed the amount of funds estimated by the City to be available to finance the contract.

Obligation of Bidder: At the time of the opening of bids each Bidder will be presumed to have inspected the site and to have read and to be thoroughly familiar with all requirements contained herein, whether written out in full or implied. The failure or omission of any Bidder to examine any form, instrument, regulation or document shall in no way relieve any Bidder from any obligation in respect of his/her Bid.

The contractor shall not sublet, assign, transfer, convey, sell, or otherwise dispose of any portion of the contract, his right, title or interest therein, or his power to execute such contract, to any person, firm or corporation without written consent of the City, and such written consent shall not be construed to relieve the bidder of any responsibility for the fulfillment of the contract.

Submission: Submit one copy of the executed bid on the Bid Proposal Form provided (pages 4 and 5) as well as any required documents. The bid shall be enclosed in a sealed, opaque envelope, clearly identified on the outside as "Sealed Bid R0110-23" and the Contractor's Name. Bids must be delivered or mailed to:

All bid proposals must be received no later than the posted deadline of Monday, March 6, 2023, at 2:00pm CST. Bid packages submitted after the posted date and time will not be accepted. Proposals may not be withdrawn after the opening date. The City of Riverside reserves the right to reject any and all bids. Please make sure that each item is included within your bid package. Failure to provide a complete package of submittals may result in disqualification from the bid process.
