

## **SHORT-TERM RENTAL COMPLAINT FORM**

A short-term residential rental is a rental of all, or a portion of the residential property for periods of less than 30 days. Short-term rentals are only allowed in registered residential units and are regulated by the Revenue & Inspections (R&I) office. You may file a complaint via e-mail, mail or in person.

## **CONCERNS**

If you have concerns about the following issues with a current STR location please note it in your complaint.

- The host is operating short-term rentals without a STR License.
- Parking on Street Off-street parking must be provided on the premises.
- Tourist overcrowding or using to host event.
- Noise or parties that are directly associated with tourists staying at a short-term rental. For immediate noise or party complaints please contact Riverside Police Department at 205-884-3333 (police non-emergency line) and/or also let the R&I office know.
- Excess trash, vehicles parking on sidewalks, vehicles blocking driveways, damage to personal property or adjacent properties, tresspassing.
- Un-permitted construction inside the property, or un-permitted use of sheds, tents, garages, recreational vehicles (RVs), and non-residential properties for short-term rentals.

To file your complaint, you may either:
